Ice Skating for Kindergarten & MWF classes (TTh will have this one to look forward to next year.) This is a fun-filled experience! It is what I call a stretch for kids & parents. We rent skates for the kids unless you have them already. (I know we have one student who is learning to play hockey!) Parents may be on the ice with shoes or skates to help, if desired, but not required. Callie, who is a gold test skater, will be on hand both days to coach the kids. They may start out using the bars to help them stay upright, but you will be surprised at how quickly they are able to go on their own.

REGISTRATION FOR FALL for 2017-2018

Registration will be open to in-house families first on January 9th. Open registration begins January 19th. Kindergarten (5 yrs old by September 1st) will be \$240/month; MWF Preschool(4 yrs old by September 1st) will be \$165; TTh Preschool (3 yrs old by September 1st) will be \$140. Come in for registration forms or pick one up outside the office. We do not advertise, so please pass the word around.

We will skate (including putting on skates, etc) for about an hour. Permission slips and sign up sheets are available. Snow pants, if you have them, and gloves are a good idea. A HELMET is required. No child will be allowed on the ice without a helmet!!! If your child does not have one, please let us know so we can help. NOTICE SOME CLASSES HAVE CHANGED DATES!!! It will be a field trip that won't take the full school day but you are welcome to just attend for the ice skating. Just let your teacher know what you decide to do. We will meet at the Eagles Ice Arena at 9:45 am and can return to school or go home from there. Siblings are welcome but may not be able to rent skates if there is an equipment shortage.

FUND RAISER

In the Spring, we will be holding a Trike-a-thon! All preschool kids and Kindergarteners are encouraged to participate. All siblings are invited. Children are allowed to ride anything with wheels. Watch for details. SAVE THE DATE . . . May 12th!
